



## COVID 19 and Health Protocols

### For the 54<sup>th</sup> Governor's Cup & the Youth Match Racing World Championship

as of June 1, 2021



#### Club rules and provisions

1. Provide Hand sanitizer and wash stations at access points for competitors and volunteers.
2. Signage for social distancing and masks will be posted to remind adherence to rules.
- 3: Screening station for temperature check and Covid symptom questionnaire will be at entrance station for daily check
4. All skippers meetings, meals and other regatta related events, will be held outside under a large tent with fully open sides. Masks will be required for any brief entrance into the Clubhouse.

*Strick adherence to protocol operation will be required for the duration of these events. Any club member, staff, volunteer or competitor who fails to follow guidelines will be subject to restriction from all regatta events, or interaction with competitors, staff or officials, an/or disqualification from participation.*

#### Testing and Vaccination .

5. Club will assure all participating staff have been vaccinated. Any unvaccinated staff will be required to have proof of PCR NASAL TESTING NO LATER THAN 48 HOURS from start of event and will be subject to periodic testing during the event.
6. As this remains a very difficult situation to monitor we strongly encourage that full vaccination for all staff and volunteers prior to the event is critical , with the only exceptions for medical or religious purposes.
7. Competitors and volunteers , judges and officials expected to have considerable contact with athletes must show proof of vaccination for validation prior to starting the event
8. The organizers understand that nations have had different vaccination rates and levels. For international travelers who are not vaccinated will be tested upon arrival 48 hrs. before the event, during the event, and at completion before travel. If desired, they may receive a vaccination. Testing and vaccination will be provided without cost to international competitors and officials and both will be provided on site at Balboa Yacht Club.
9. All guests or club members attending any of the dinner events or onsite during the presence of the competitor will need validation of vaccination or Negative PCR test at their cost and responsibility to gain admission. Those who are unvaccinated will be required to wear a mask at all times per the CDC guidelines. No direct interaction with the athletes will be allowed for this group.
10. Members of host families are required to be vaccinated, if eligible, no later than three weeks before the event.

#### Positive Tests

Should any competitor or judge be tested positive they will be immediately isolated. The remaining team members will be tested. Substitution of competitors regulations in such an event will be described in the NoR as it may be modified by the Sailing Instructions.
